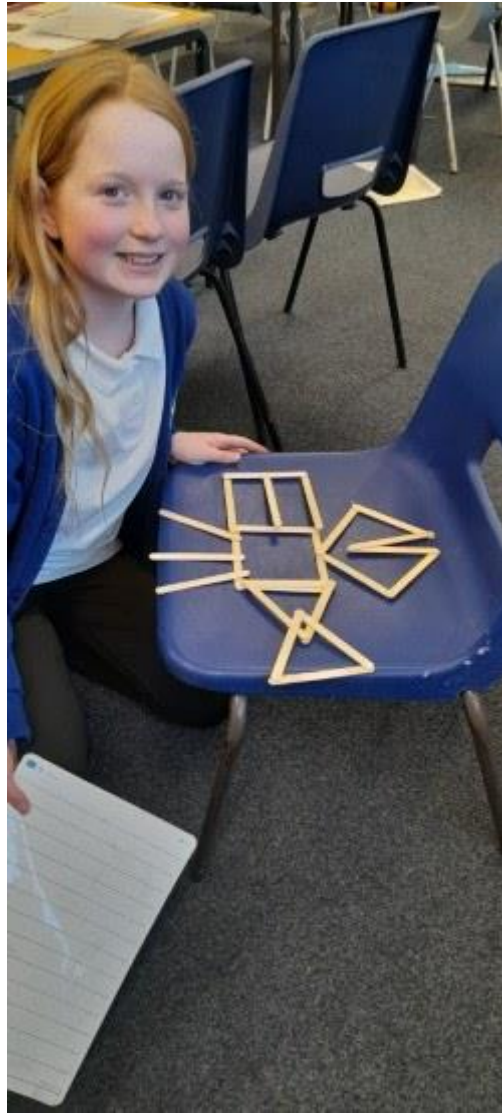

Friskney Wellbeing Hub is working in partnership with Friskney Friends to provide a safe place for people to meet, socialise & talk.



Tuesdays 1 till 3pm
