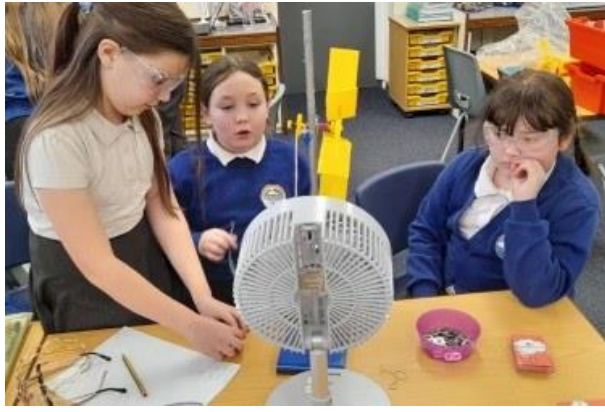

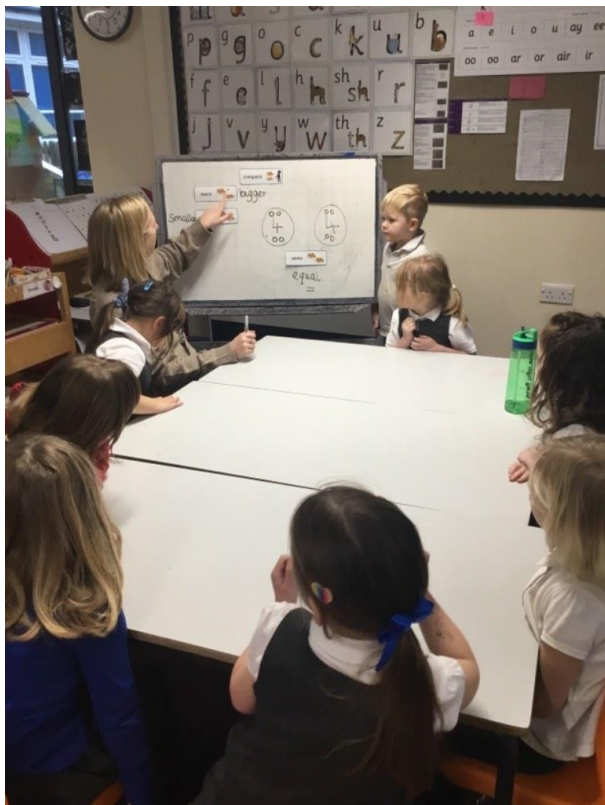

The sessions are designed to support families to practice Makaton and develop their communication skills with their children. The sessions are funded by the virtual Autism hub for children with a diagnosis of Autism, however, we are aware that a lot of under 6's may not have a diagnosis yet. We welcome anyone who have a communication difficulty or any families who feel they would like some support.

Reminders

- **PE days this term: Nursery and Reception - Monday and Friday. Years 1/2 - Monday and Friday. Years 3/4 - Tuesday and Wednesday. Years 5/6 - Tuesday and Friday**
- **Please ensure that all school meals are booked via MCAS by Wednesday for the following week.**
- **If you require before or after school care, we do run a breakfast club from 07:45am – 08:30am for a cost of £3. Our core after-school club runs from 3:00pm – 4:15pm at a cost of £5 (Discount for those in receipt of Pupil Premium or Young Carers). If you require our EXTENDED after school club, it is an additional £3 for the provision from 4.15-5.30pm. All MUST be booked via MCAS as we are unable to put these on**

via the office. If you would like any more information about either of these, please feel free to contact the school office.

- If your child has a Doctors/Dentist appointment can you please show us the appointment letter or card so this can be put with your child's records. If you have been sent a text message for the appointment, please can you screen shot this and email it to enquiries@friskney.laat.co.uk.
