Curriculum Letters

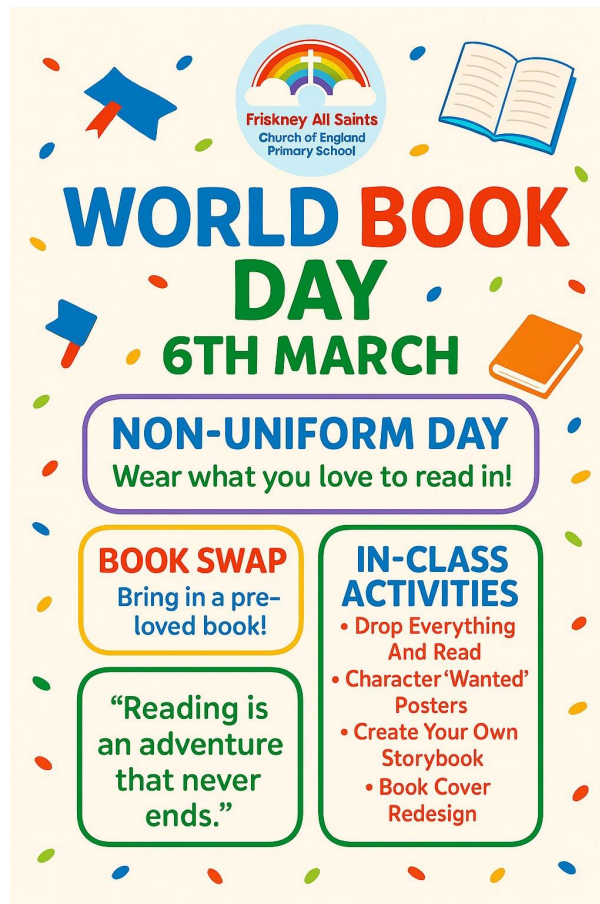
We work hard to keep families updated on what your children are learning. As it is the start of term, curriculum letters will be making their way to you next week.
