FREE BREAKFAST CLUB TO START AFTER EASTER

We are thrilled to let families know that **after the Easter holidays, our school will be launching the *Best Start in Life* Free Breakfast Club.**

The Breakfast Club will run **every morning from 7:45am to 8:30am** and is **free of charge** for all children from **Reception to Year 6**. A breakfast of **cereal or toast** will be provided.

Although the club is free for everyone, **parents will still need to book a place**, so that we can ensure we have appropriate staffing and food available each day.

Children are welcome to attend for any reason, including:

- To support with **childcare** in the mornings.
- To access a **free breakfast** before school begins.
- To enjoy a **calm, settled start** to the day, away from the busyness of the playground before the morning bell.

Please note that the **toast provided in class for all children at the start of the school day will continue as normal**, regardless of whether they attend Breakfast Club.

If your child already accesses breakfast club at the school, be reassured that you won't notice any significant changes other than the benefit to your wallet!

We hope this initiative helps to make mornings easier for families and provides children with a positive, nourishing start to their learning day.



Our core after-school club runs from 3:00pm – 4:15pm at a cost of £5 (Discount for those in receipt of Pupil Premium or Young Carers). If you require our EXTENDED after school club, it is an additional £3 for the provision from 4.15-5.30pm. All MUST be booked via MCAS as we are unable to put these on via the office. If you would like any more information about either of these, please feel free to contact the school office.**
- **If your child has a Doctors/Dentist appointment can you please show us the appointment letter or card so this can be put with your child's records. If you have been sent a text message for the appointment, please can you screen shot this and email it to enquiries@friskney.laat.co.uk.**
