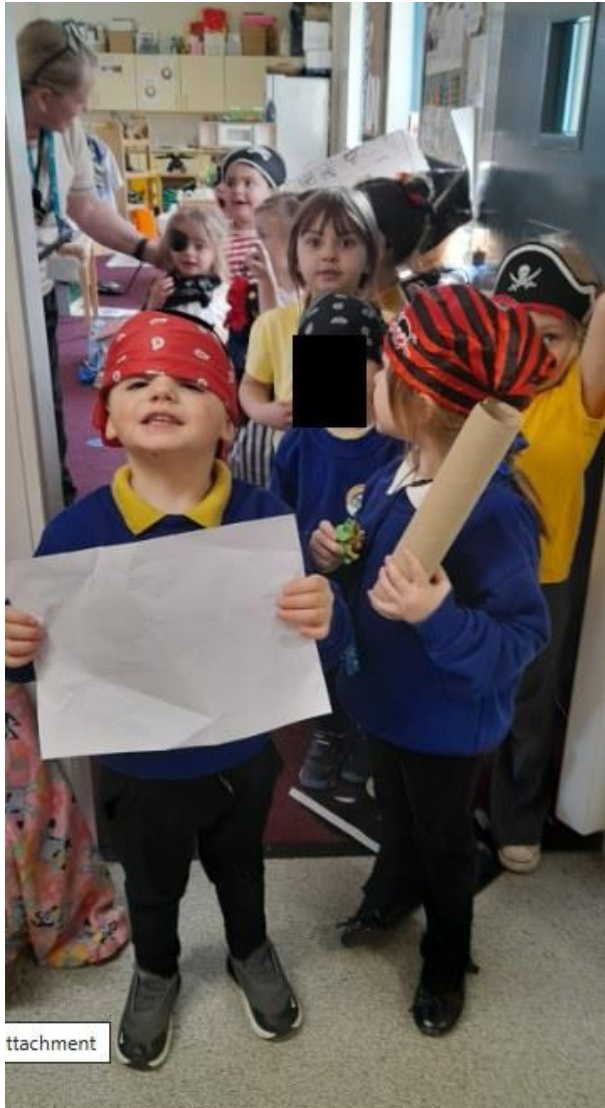



Reminders

- PE days this term: Nursery and Reception - Monday and Friday. Years 1/2 - Monday and Friday. Years 3/4 - Tuesday and Wednesday. Years 5/6 - Tuesday and Friday
- Please ensure that all school meals are booked via MCAS by Wednesday for the following week.
- If you require before or after school care, we do run a breakfast club from 07:45am – 08:30am for a cost of £3. Our core after-school club runs from 3:00pm – 4:15pm at a cost of £5 (Discount for those in receipt of Pupil Premium or Young Carers). If you require our EXTENDED after school club, it is an additional £3 for the provision from 4.15-5.30pm. All MUST be booked via MCAS as we are unable to put these on via the office. If you would like any more information about either of these, please feel free to contact the school office.
- If your child has a Doctors/Dentist appointment can you please show us the appointment letter or card so this can be put with your child's records. If you have been sent a text message for the appointment, please can you screen shot this and email it to enquiries@friskney.laat.co.uk.

- Nursery funding: To get your 30 hour code for funded nursery places, please visit www.lincolnshire.gov.uk/fundedchildcare¹
- Parking at school: Can parents/carers please ensure that they are not parking both sides of the road as it is dangerous when tractors/buses etc are trying to drive through. If you are able to, please can you consider parking in the Village Hall car park, which will alleviate the problem. Thank you.
