Safeguarding Update – NSPCC “PANTS” Message

We regularly teach children about keeping their bodies safe, including the NSPCC’s “PANTS” rule, which is a simple and age-appropriate way to help children understand personal boundaries. It reminds children that **Privates are private, Always remember your body belongs to you, No means no, Talk about secrets that upset you, and Speak up—someone can help.** This message empowers children to feel confident about speaking to a trusted adult if they are worried or uncomfortable.
