We're thrilled to share that our Farm School has received funding to run for the entire academic year 2025/26! More information about dates will follow, but **our first visit will be for Years 5 and 6 on September 18th.**

### **Medical updates**

Thank you to all families who have returned medication to school. I will be contacting families over the next couple of weeks to ensure our medical paperwork is up to date. We've made a small change to our 'bumped head' notifications: as we no longer have text facilities, we will now make a quick phone call to inform you if your child has bumped their head. If we're unable to reach you, we'll leave a message and follow up with a message via MCAS.

Our short-term medication policy remains the same: if your child is prescribed medication that needs administering three times a day or less, we ask that this is managed around school hours. If it needs to be given four times a day, please bring it to the school office and complete the relevant paperwork so we can administer it during the school day.

A reminder that **we are a nut-free school.** We have children with severe nut allergies, and we thank you for your continued cooperation in keeping our school safe.
