School Uniform

Our uniform includes:

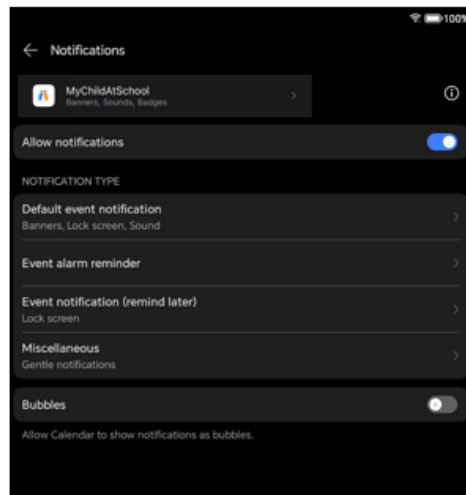
