Dear Parents/Carers

I wouldn't ordinarily send out a newsletter during the holidays, however I wanted to let parents know about the new arrangements for next half term.

Following the parental questionnaire that went out a few weeks ago, there was a lot of positive feedback about the prospect of bringing together our extra curricular clubs and our after school care. Thank you to everyone who took part in the questionnaire, your feedback has helped to shape what next term will look like.

Previously, we offered after school wrap-around care separate to our extra curricular clubs. We are now combining the two. This means there will now be a charge for after school clubs but with a much wider variety. Families in receipt of Pupil Premium will be charged at a significantly discounted rate. For parents who need the provision for childcare reasons, please be reassured that there will still be after school provision until 4.15pm every day. If you need childcare for your child but they are not keen on the club offer that day, they will not be forced to take part. They can choose to do something different.

Thank you to those who expressed an interest in after school care beyond 4.15pm. We are currently looking into ways we can make this financially viable.
