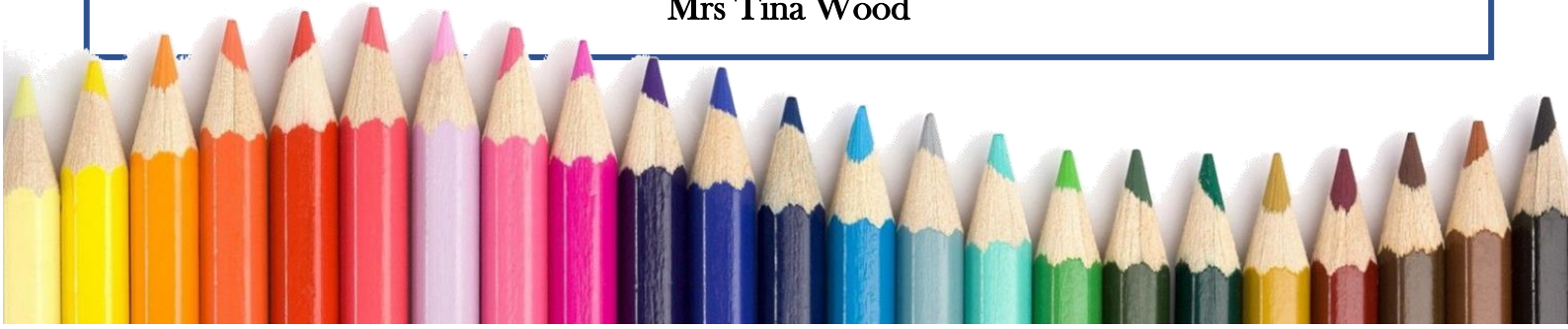
Dear Parents/Carers
